An ex-militant has been shot dead in Port Harcourt, Rivers State. He was suspected to have been killed by members of his cult group. The victim, simply identified as Peter, was said to be a member of a cult group known as Iclander.

Peter was said to have been shot dead when he attended a party organised by a female friend of a member of his cult group. *Daily Sun* gathered that the dead ex-militant, though not the second-in-command, was a 'hitman' and controlled much influence in the group.

A source, who lives within the vicinity of their stronghold, who did not want his name to be printed, attributed his killing to disaffection in the group over his domineering tendencies.
