The Acting Controller of TI-MARIV, Mr. Confidence Eke, decried the repeated killing of the agency's personnel in the state, pointing out that two of his men were shot dead by gunmen within a week. Eke gave the names of the two officers killed by armed men as John Dimkpa and Precious Pepple. disclosed that ad kpa was killed by gunmen at Wimpey/Ikwerre Road checkpoint in Port Harcourt on March 26, 2015, while the second victim, Pepple, was shot dead by yet-to-be-identified gunmen, while on duty at Amadi-Ama in the state capital. idi TIMARIV boss, had in the ge petition addressed to Karma stated: "On Thursday, March of 26, 2015, at about 15.02hrs, asone officer, John Dimkpa, ect posted to Wimpey/Ikwerre ist, Road checkpoint for traffic SO duties, was shot dead by unfe, known persons. ne in The case was promptly reported at the Kala Police Diide visional Headquarters. Also, eson Wednesday, April 1, 2015, at the Amadi-Ama Area of ion the City, one officer, Precious es, Pepple, was equally killed by gethe unknown persons. ich "It is against this background that we write to seek OSyour intervention by carrying hat out an indebt investigation into ng, these killings and also ensure anadequate protection of our officers. These measures will go em, a long way in boosting confiuel dence of our officers in carryate ing out their duties." peexplained that ive MARIV was established by ow law to control traffic, maintainlid.
