Hoodlums kill pregnant woman, 2 others in Warri

A pregnant woman has met her untimely death following the serious injury she sustained when she was pushed out of a moving tricycle by suspected armed robbers.

The victim whose name could not be immediately ascertained at Press time, was said to be returning from a journey when she boarded the tri-cycle at about 7pm along

Enerhen Junction in Warri.

Eyewitnesses said the expectant Yoruba woman had phoned her husband that she was already in Warri, but on getting to Ginuwa Junction, she was attacked by three bandits who suspected that the bag she was carrying contained money and valuables.

The victim who hit her head against the pavement, could not survive the fatal injury as she died on the way to the hospital.

The remains of the victim whose age was put at 26, had been deposited at the Central Hospital morgue, Warri.

Meanwhile, two tri-cycle riders have been killed at Effurun and Iyara axis in Warri metropolis.

Crime Watch Today investigation revealed that one of the victims was shot in the head while the other was stabbed.

At least, 10 people have been killed in Warri and Effurun by hoodlums who have laid a siege on the neighbouring communities since the beginning of this year.

Fear has gripped the residents of Warri as serious effort was being made by the police to curb the increasing wave of crime in the area.
