

# 3 teenagers die in Kwara community well

**P**eople of Okerimi-Oro community in Irepodun Local Government Area of Kwara State have been thrown into mourning over the death of three secondary school boys

that drowned inside a well at the weekend.

Daily Sun investigation revealed that the three teenagers, whose ages ranged between 14 and 15 were students of Ayaki Secondary School located in the area.

It was gathered that one of the three victims had tried to fetch wa-

ter from the well in the community to perform ablution last Friday when he incidentally fell inside the well.

"Instead of alerting adults around to rescue their drowning mate, the other two victims, in their attempts at rescuing their dying colleague jumped into the well

and were later found dead, thereby throwing the entire community into mourning mood," a member of the community said.

Efforts to speak with parents of the deceased proved abortive as they refused to talk with journalists, while relations described the incident as an act of God.
