The speeding truck, which was heading to Oshodi knocked him down. The driver sped off. The man did not die immediately, but there was no help in sight.

"If help had come on time, may be the man would survived. I wonder why people refused to use the pedestrian bridges," an eyewitness stated.

The victim, whose identity could not be ascertained as at Press time, was said to be in his '30s.
