One killed, 2 injured in Anambra auto crash

was recorded yesterday in Anambra
State when a truck laden
with fresh tomatoes fell
on a Sport Utility Vehicle
(SUV) and crushed the
driver to death. Both the
truck driver and his conductor escaped, but sustained injuries.

According to an eyewitness, the incident happened at a particular spot
along Ogidi/Abatete road
in Abatete, Idemili North
Local Government Area,
when the two affected vehicles coming from opposite directions were trying
to dodge a bump, and in
the process the container

carried by the truck fell on the SUV.

It took the concerted efforts of the local vigilance group led by Mr. Arthur Ilongwu and some other passers-by to bring out the trapped corpse of the SUV driver, who reportedly died on the spot. According to the leader of the vigilance group, the incident occurred as a result of the height of the bump. He said: "The bump is too high for vehicles, especially those carrying heavy goods. The state government or Abatete people should reduce the height of the bump to forestall future occurrence". As at the time of filing this report, there was a serious gridlock along the road as a result of the incident.
