Police arrest armed robbery suspect

THE Delta State Police Command has arrested a 36-year-old armed robbery suspect, Nduka Azu (aka Nwankwu), for allegedly killing Fidelis Achigbue and injuring Dele Chibogu on his right hand and left shoulder before he went into hiding. He was nabbed recently at Abbi town in the state.

Items recovered from the suspect include one American made pistol, one single barrel gun, two live cartridges, handsets, flash drive and charms.

Meanwhile, suspected members of the gang who opened fired on the detective in an attempt to free Nwankwu was repelled. Investigation and efforts to apprehend other members of the criminal gang are ongoing.

In the same vein, the command has deployed detectives to all parts of the state to clamp down on sellers and users of fireworks during this festive periods.
