

Spiritualist kills two brothers, buries them in his compound

A suspected evil spiritualist has allegedly murdered two brothers in Kogi State.

According to *Daily Sun* investigation, the brothers, Tanko Abuba-

kar, an Architect, and Kudu Abubakar, a Carpenter, met their untimely death when they sought spiritual assistance from Mallam Ibrahim Muhammed, a Muslim cleric.

Muhammed, 35, it was gathered is cleric in Bida, Niger State.

Due to the lull in the patronage of their businesses, the two brothers were said to have contacted Mohammed who told them to come for a two-day spiritual cleansing and prayers at his new location in Kungbani.

But on getting to the Mohammed's house, he was said to have charged them N10,000 to enable him buy the materials which he would use for the prayers and spiritual cleansing for the two brothers which they paid.

The cleric then traveled to Lokoja, a distance of 10 kilometres but instead of buying the spiritual materials, he was said to have bought, poisonous concoction which he mixed with some substances and gave them to drink.

He later told them to have a bed rest for some minutes to allow the concoction to

their aura and attract their elusive fortune.

As the two brothers, who after few minutes were said to be writhing in pain tried to complain, the Mohammed was said to have smashed their heads with a big pestle, killing them before he buried them in his compound.

He immediately took their red colour Toyota Camry car with Registration number BDA 902 AA to a Panel beater in Lokoja, changed the colour to gold and changed the registration number before converting it to his private use.

Speaking exclusively to *Daily Sun* on the incident the State Police Commissioner, Mr Bessan Gwana, said the case was reported to them by the elder brother of the deceased Muhammed Abubakar, who lives in Abuja.

Lagos judiciary moves

THE Lagos State judiciary has launched a major offensive against touts who operate within the vicinity of the Ikeja and Lagos divisions of the courts.
