

Suspected cultist killed by rival group

A suspected cultist (name withheld), has been reportedly killed by a rival group in Nkpor, Idemili North Local Government Area of Anambra State.

The victim, identified as a barber in the area, was killed at the weekend and dumped at Afor-Nkpor Market. His body was later discovered the following day before police were alerted.

A source said the victim

was a member of another cult group in the area, who may have been targeted during the clash between the two rival cult groups over supremacy in the area.

The Ogidi Divisional Police Officer (DPO), Mr. Hassan Musa, who confirmed the killing, said he personally moved to the marketplace where the corpse was dumped and took it to the Iyi-Enu Hospital morgue.

According to him, "when we got the information

that a corpse was dumped at Afor-Nkpor Market, I led a team of policemen to the place and we took the corpse to Iyi-Enu mortuary. Preliminary investigation showed that he was killed by a rival group and dumped at Afor-Nkpor Market in the early hours of yesterday".

Musa further said no arrest had been made so far but noted that investigation was ongoing to arrest those that perpetrated the dastardly act.
