Fear grips residents as cultists invade town

NKPOR community in Idemili Local Government Area of Anambra State is now under the siege of cultists that invaded the town, leaving two people dead in two separate attacks within three days.

Daily Sun gathered that on Saturday, a middle aged Baber was killed by some unknown persons believed to be members of a secret cult who struck in his area.

His body was later dropped by his killers at Affor Nkpor in early in the morning where he was discovered by passers-by who reported the incident to the police.

Niether the full identity of the deceased nor his home town was known as at the time of going to the press.

In a similar development, the body of another young man, suspected to have been killed by a cult group, was discovered near Crown Hospital, Nkpor.

Police sources said the deceased was a victim of cult attack. According to the source, the deceased was killed by a rival cult group who attacked him on his way to work.

The Divisional Police Officer for Ogidi Police Division, Mr. Hassan Musa, said the bodies of the two victims had been collected by the police and deposited in the mortuary.

Mr Musa also said investigation was already in top gear by his men to fish out the cultists

He called on members of the community to report any suspected person or movement to the police to enable them track down the cultists.
