A TENANT has killed a co-tenant at the old Ewu Road, Mafoluku, Oshodi area of Lagos metropolis.

The deceased, Ebuka Agbo, had gone to plead with the suspect, Chinonso Ewerem to remove the dead rat emitting offensive odour from his room.

The suspect, who was angered by the victim's request, warned him to leave his room or risked his wrath.

Agbo, 25, allegedly scolded Ewerem, 19, telling him that he should respect him, gave him a knock on his head and walked away.

The landlord, Alhaji Gazeli Olu-biyo told *Daily Sun*: "On the fateful day, Ebuka Agbo, who lived next to Ewerem's room, had gone to advise him to remove the rotten rat in his room, but Ewerem was angry at Agbo for challenging him. There was minor argument

and I learnt that Agbo slapped Ewerem, warning him to respect him as his elder.

"After the quarrel, Agbo left the house and several hours later, he returned home and he was opening his door when Ewerem attacked him. He hit him with a heavy object on his head and Agbo collapsed. Ewerem, who

saw the magnitude of his action, took to his heels.

"We didn't bother to chase him as we were all concerned with Agbo's life, so, we rushed him to a private hospital, but we were referred to Lagos State University Hospital(LASUTH),Ikeja where he died five days later. When, Ewerem later returned home, we handed him over to the Makinde Police Station"
