volved in supremacy battle. Last week Sunday, members of suspected cultists struck at Ikokoro/Sakamo area of Ilorin and killed a boy simply identified as Wasiu.

The latest bloody cult dash occurred at Babako, Ita-Amodu and Agbo-Oba areas of Ilorin metropolis between Saturday's night and 4am on Sunday morning.

The development, according to sources, created tension in the affected areas while residents scampered for safety. Witness told journalists that, at the end of the clash, four persons including a 20- yearold boy were shot by the cultists.

It was gathered that, the members of "Aiye" fraternity first struck at Baboko area of Ilorin around 9.30 p.m on Saturday night and allegedly killed two persons. HOT LINES: Do you have any information on

val cult groups said to be in- It was further gathered that, after the operation at Baboko, the suspected cultists at Baboko area headed for Ita-Amodu and Agbo-Oba areas of Ilorin on revenge mission.

This group also allegedly killed two persons in the areas. When contacted, the spokesman of the state police command, Ajayi Okasanmi, who confirmed the incident said that, "I can confirm one person to you that has been killed by the suspected cultists and this happened at Babaoko area of Ilorin. Men of the state police command has taken his corpse to the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UITH)".

Ajayi who warned cultists to stay away from the state said, "henceforth, any one caught will be made to face the full wrath of the law."
