

Two murdered in Lagos

Daily Sun gathered that Sunday Joseph was allegedly shot dead by some customs men at Anike Apena Area off Unity Bus-stop, Ikeja.

④ An eyewitness, John Uche, told *Daily Sun* that Joseph was sighted in

the evening jumping from roof to roof, trying to rob houses and some people who saw him raised the alarm which attracted some customs men who were on duty.

Uche said, "the customs of-

ficers asked him to come down but he refused and he was shot and he fell down from the roof and died instantly. We all ran away as the customs men abandoned the corpse on the street".

It was gathered that a 56-year-old woman, Silifat Ayodele was allegedly murdered by suspected security guard at plot 25, site Afssa, Satellite town of the metropolis.

Daily Sun gathered that the suspected security guard has fled after the murder.

The State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Dolapo Badmos who confirmed the two suspected murder cases, said, "It is true, there was a report that a suspected robber, Sunday Joseph, 32, was found jumping from roof to roof trying to steal from houses and he was shot by unknown customs men at Anike Apena, off unity, Ikeja. The Ikeja Police division is investigating the killing.

She said in another development, a woman Silifat Ayodele was murdered by unknown persons at Satellite town.

"We have stepped up manhunt for a security guard in the area and other colleagues, now at large suspected to have perpetrated the act. The corpse has been deposited at the Navy Hospital, Satellite Town for autopsy."

their children.

She said that the teenager's confessional statement helped the Police to arrest another member of the group, Mohammed Korede, 19.

The two suspects have been transferred to Gender Department of the police command for necessary actions.
