

Man stabs brother to death in Ebonyi

BARELY one week after a man beheaded has his 60-year-old step-mother in Ebonyi State, another person has allegedly stabbed

his younger brother to death during an argument arising from family matter in Nwogayi market, in the same Izzi Council Area of the State.

Daily Sun gathered that the suspect, aged 35, (name

withheld) has been arrested for allegedly stabbing his younger brother to death during a fierce argument that led to physical combat.

It was further gathered that the suspect, stabbed during a fierce argument, rested while the victim died on his way to the hospital. Confirming the incident, the State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO),

ASP George Okafor, said the incident happened at Nwogayi Market in Izzi Local Government Area of the state.

The PPRO also said that the officers at Izzi Divisional Police Station visited

the scene of the attack, recovered the corpse and deposited it in an undisclosed mortuary for autopsy while investigation has commenced.

"We are yet to ascertain the cause of the quarrel

which led to the stabbing but police will get to the root of the matter."

Meanwhile, most of the people who witnessed the stabbing of the victim have expressed joy over the news of the arrest of the

killer."

The PPRO said that the case would soon be transferred to the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) for thorough investigation and necessary action.
