4 die as cultists storm police station

Kogi State.

A game of gunmen, suspected to be cultists, at the weak end shot dead a 27-year-old man at Ayegbe Street in Idah.

The victim, Jelairu Ugebeba, was said to have been killed in a vicious attack during which several other persons sustained bullet injuries. It was learnt that after kill-

ing their target, the assailants embarked on a show of bravado as they trailed the corpse in a red Golf car to the Divisional police headquarters at Idah, where it was taken for a formal complaint

to be lodged, and fired sporadically into the station. Sources hinted that in the process, a police officer, Sergeant Nnajim Suleiman sustained bullet injuries on his right knee and was taken

to Odoma Clinic, Idah, for treatment.

Our correspondent further gathered that on Sunday, barely 24 hours after the incident, three other persons among those hit by stray bul-

lets who were also receiving treatment at the same hospital died, while Ugbeba's corpse had been deposited at the mortuary.

Police spokesman for Kogi State command, ASP

Williams Ovey, could not be reached for comments, but a senior officer who does not want to be named confirmed the incident.

He said the killing was not unconnected with a cult
