Security guard hacked to death

A MIDDLE aged man and a security guard attached to Mobile Telecommunication Nigeria(MTN) booster station at Chokonaeze community in Ezinihitte Mbaise Council Area of Imo State was yesterday hacked to death by unknown assailants. The mutilated body of the deceased simply identified as Mr. Umunakwe from Ndiuhu village in Chokonaeze was found the following

morning by inhabitants of the community who raised the alarm. It was gathered that the deceased's hands were tied with his cloth before being hacked to death by his assailants who later dumped his body on the road.

A source said the deceased had laid complaints at Ezinihitte Mbaise Police Division over threat to his life by some of his kinsmen over a land dispute.

Sunday Sun gathered that eight suspects had been arrested by the police in connection with the incident.
