Port Harcourt: 5 killed in collapsed warehouse only be From Tony John, Port

Harcourt

FIVE persons died yesterday, when a warehouse collapsed in Port Harcourt, Rivers State.

Daily Sun gathered that the warehouse, used in storing salt, was situated at Area One Seaport, Port Harcourt.

A source, who works at

the Seaport, who declined to be named, said the warehouse was as old as the seaport and that the building caved in when it could not carry the weight of the salt.

He said the product, which had not been filled in bags, flowed to the toilet and bathroom where the deceased were.

"As the warehouse collapsed, the salt flowed like water. It entered the toilet and bathroom. Unfortunately, people were inside. People who were outside when the incident happened and knew that some workers were in the toilet ran inside. Five persons were dragged out dead. We are yet to know whether there were other casualties. One of the victims was known as Mathaias. He hailed from Ahoada, Rivers State," the source disclosed. As at the time of filing this report, police spokesperson in charge of Area One Seaport, Port Harcourt could not be reached to confirm the incident.
