Killers of police area commander nabbed

THE members of the gang that killed 52-year-old Joseph Otiegbe,

a deputy superintendent of police in Aba, Abia State have been arrested. The Abia State Commission-er of Police, Joshak Habila who disclosed this to Sunday Sun said the five-member gang of robbers specialized in killing policeman whether at checkpoints or the police man was wearing mufti. They would just shoot him and take his AK 47 rifle, which they use for robbery

operations.

He said that the same gang had killed over 10 policemen in the course of their murderous operations. He further disclosed that the gang resides in Aba and was part of a syndicate that also engaged in

The gang shot him on the right side of his stomach and on his left leg and he died at the spot.



Suspects

Habila stated that the gang abandoned the kidnapping operation that brought them to the place and fled.

The Special Armed Robbery Squad, SARS of the Abia Command as well as the Mopol 28 and Mopol 85 launched a massive manhunt for the gang and combed Aba in search

The Assistant commissioner of police, Area commander, Aba, Mr. Peter Wagbara further told Sunday Sun that the gang came back to Aba on April 20, 2016 to kidnap another victim. Through information made available to the police, detectives trailed them. In the exchange of gunfire, he said that three of the suspects

were shot and arrested while the others escaped with bullet wounds.

One of the suspects, Orji Okoro told the Sunday Sun that the gang always got information from a certain Hausa man in Aba and each time it carried our a successful operation, it paid him some money. He also disclosed that the man was now

at large. His words: "We have one Alhaji who was our gang member. Any victim that we kidnapped in Aba, it was the Alhaji who always kept the victim until the relatives paid the ransom before the person would be released by the Alhaji from our hideout."

"Our gang leader who is at large is from Nkporo in Abia State and he was the one that kept custody of our arms and ammunition. We are the ones that killed a policeman in mufti. We discovered that he had a pistol with him. We shot him and took his pistol.

"We have killed several policemen at checkpoints and kidnapped several victims in Aba."

Wagbara stated that a vehicle with the registration number No. HT 321 AAA as well as Otiegbe's pistol with eight rounds of ammunition were recovered by the police.

Habila added that the three suspects were still being held at the State Criminal Investigation Department, Umuahia, Abia State for further interrogation. Meanwhile the police are still on the trail of the gang leader and other members of the syndicate.
