

Police nab murder suspect after 4 years

THE Sokoto State Police Command has arrested a murder suspect, Atiku Abubakar Galadima over his alleged role in the killing of his cousin four years ago.

The deceased, Sirajo Abubakar, a lawyer, was said to have been invited for an outing by the suspect before his decomposed body was found at Dundaye village in Wamakko Local Government Area of the state.

Parading the suspect with others, the Commissioner of Police, Alhaji Salisu Fagge Abdullahi, said since the murder, he fled the state to an unknown destination.

"The dexterity of detectives on intelligence gathering paid off as the suspect was arrested in Sokoto on June 22, 2016 after four years of manhunt. Abdullahi explained.

In a related development, Abdullahi also paraded two members of the Shiite Islamic sect arrested for illegal procession.

He said the suspects were caught brandishing dangerous weapons during the illegal procession.

The commissioner assured that the suspects would soon be charged to court.
