

Tenant kills neighbour in Lagos

...Teenager too

A tenant has killed a neighbour at Omotoye Estate, Orile, Agege, Lagos.

It was gathered that the tenants, Ebere Akpu and Monday Eze were quarreling over an undisclosed matter.

The quarrel degenerated into a heated argument which later snowball into serious fight.

A witness, Chibuike Anya, said: "As Akpu and Eze were quarreling, we tried to separate them, but they refused to stop fighting.

"As we were settling the fight, Eze ran out and resurfaced with a cutlass which he used in attacking Akpu. We ran for cover and later came back and met Akpu g on the ground.

"We rushed him to the hospital. Unfortunately, he died on the way.

The State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) Dolapo Badmos, said the case was reported by one Gozie

John that his brother, Ebere Akpu, 55 was attacked with machete by one Monday.

She said the victim died on the way to the hospital and the body deposited at the Mainland Hospital.

She said the case has been transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti.

In another development, a teenage footballer killed another at the Okota area of the metropolis.

It was gathered that two groups were playing a football match at Okota area, when suddenly the game turned into a theatre of war.

It was gathered that during the fracas, a young boy, Kayode Babayanju, stabbed Michael Tanko in his stomach with a broken bottle.

A witness Biola Awofisibe said: "After stabbing him, Babayanju took to his heel. We rushed Tanko to the hospital, but he died on the way."

Badmos who confirmed the incident said the death occurred at Oseni Laide street, OKota.
