One dead, 11 injured in Ogun tanker explosion

one person died yesterday in a road mishap involving a fuel tanker, an articulated vehicle and a bus in Sagamu, Ogun State.

Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in the state, Adegoke Adetunji, said no fewer than 11 people also suffered injuries in the accident that an eyewitness said occurred in the early hours.

He said the tanker, loaded with petrol had a mechanical problem and stopped on the road, while the bus and truck rammed into it resulting in explosion.

He said that the tanker caught fire and burnt other two vehicles, adding that the dead and the injured had been taken to hospital.
