Hotelier murdered in Niger, another man slumps, dies

A popular hotelier was found dead weekend inside his office at Madalla, Suleja Local Government Area of Niger State, in circumstances the police described as a case of homicide perpetrated by "an insider."

The deceased identified as Lucky Okonkwo, was the chairman of the Association of Hoteliers in Suleja and proprietor of Deplo Hotels, Madalla, where his lifeless body was recovered in the early hours of Saturday. A blood stained knife was also found, even as marks of violence showed in his body.

His yet-to-be-identified assailants were said to have escaped with his Peugeot 406 car with registration number KIJ424BB, to an unknown destination.

Confirming the incident, the police spokesman for the Niger State Command, DSP

Bala Elkana, said some staff of the hotel were suspected culprits as they were discovered to have fled Madalla after he was killed.

However, two female workers of the hotel are in police custody, according to Elkana, who said homicide detectives had obtained vital

clues that could lead to unmasking the perpetrators.

The development came just as a young man identified as Chinedu Aniekwu reportedly slumped and died while dancing with his friends on a social outing in an hotel at Luge, Abuja Municipal Area Council of the Federal Capital Territory.
