... Probe death of Bayelsa CJ's son

THE Police have commenced investigation into the circumstances surrounding the death of Wariebi Abiri, the son of Justice Kate Abiri, Chief Judge of Bayelsa State.

The family and Governor Henry Seriake Dickson have demanded a probe into the death.

The deceased, a student of the Nigerian Law School, Abuja was in company with his friends when

he drowned in a swimming pool at a hotel in Abuja over the weekend.

According to investigation, the family is suspecting foul play, that the the deceased might have been pushed into the water.

Since the news of his death filtered into Yenagoa, the state capital, the residence of the Abiris at Commissioners' quarters, Opolo Housing Estate has been thrown into mourning as prominent persons pay their condolence visits.

Dickson, accompanied by top

government officials regretted the manner in which the young Abiri died and assured that the government would collaborate with security agencies to unravel the real cause of death.

"As a government, be rest assured that, we will stand with you shoulder to shoulder in this very challenging period, especially, in working with the police and other relevant agencies of the government to unearth the real cause of his death," he said.
