

Artisan dies working on construction site in Enugu

Police in Enugu has commenced full-scale investigations to unravel the circumstances that led to an incident which claimed the life of a welder in Emene, a suburb of the state capital.

The victim, simply identified as one Ndubuisi was reported to have fallen from a tank in a construction site where he worked and was later confirmed dead after he was rushed to a nearby hospital.

A statement signed by the Enugu Police Public Relations Officer, Ebere Amaraizu (DSP) said the incident occurred last Friday while the deceased, an artisan(welder) whose surname is yet to be ascertained was contracted by his co artisan(welder), one Okolo Chijioke to join in a construction work on a tank in his workshop.

It was while working on the tank in the said workshop located along Enugu/Abakiliki Expressway by PRODA junction, Emene Enugu that the deceased fell and hit his head on another tank which left him unconscious.

He was consequently rushed to the Annunciation Hospital, Emene Enugu where he was confirmed dead and his corpse was subsequently deposited at the hospital mortuary.
