3 robbery suspects shot dead

THE police in Delta State have shot and killed three armed robbery suspects.

In one of the gun duels, two of the suspects had robbed Frederick, who owns Infinity Entertainment in Warri of N300,000.00, handset and other valuables.

They were pursued by the Special Anti-Robbery Squad, and in a shoot-out, the suspects were shot dead, while a pistol and car-

tridges were recovered.

Commissioner of Police, Mr. Ibrahim Zanna, who confirmed the development in Asaba, said the matter was under investigation.

He said the Safer Highway Patrol team 015 stationed at DSC Roundabout in Warri was informed about a robbery along Okpaka-Otokutu.

"Sequel to this, the team stormed the scene and exchanged fire with the armed men, during which one of the armed men died," he said.

Meanwhile, the command has launched a crusade against corruption, and the 'Change Begin with Me campaign' following the directive of the Inspector-General of Police, Mr. Ibrahim Idris.

Mr. Zanna who performed the ceremony in Asaba, said the anticorruption and Change campaigns were not targeted at policemen alone, "but extended to other government agencies and their staff.
