## Acting Rector dies of sex romp

## I'm hale and hearty -Rector

A former acting Rector of Federal Polytechnic, Ekowe, Bayelsa State, may have died as a result of alleged marathon sex with an unidentified teenager, in an hotel in Ughelli, Delta State.

The deceased allegedly slumped and died in his hotel room from what informal sources attributed to "cardiac arrest arising from the excitement."

Efforts by the management of the hotel, located at Onoharigho Street, Ughelli, to revive him were futile as he was confirmed dead on arrival by doctors of a private clinic close to the hotel.

An eyewitness said: "He went to the hotel in company of a teenager and booked a room for an hour. The girl raised an alarm when the chief slumped but absconded following reports that the victim was confirmed dead.

"Though no arrest was made, a female manager of the hotel was arrested for questioning but has since been released," the source added.

In a twist, yesterday night, Rector of the same polytechnic, Mr. Seiyaboh Idah, dismissed some online reports which had earlier named him as the deceased man.

The report, which also appeared on the website of a popular national newspaper, claimed that Idah died in an hotel in Ughelli, during a sexual activity with an undisclosed woman.

But Idah, who raised the alarm over the report when contacted, described it as "embarrassing." He further described the report as "careless, irresponsible, unprofessional and contrary to a minimum standard of journalism anywhere in the world."

He said there was nothing true about the report

and added that it was totally against his character, moral rectitude, ideals and qualities.

"I was highly embarrassed by the report. The school, the students, my family including my parents were all embarrassed and insulted by the falsehood. My friends all over the country and the world have been calling me over this incident to confirm whether I was still alive. You can see that I am alive and kicking," he added.

The rector said he hasbriefed his lawyers and asked them to take legal action against the online newspapers.
