them. Also recovered from the suspects were Motorola android, Infinix, Itel, and Techno phones which all belonged to victims of the gang's dastardly operations. One of the phones belonged to an Engineer, Adekunle Oluwayomi Enisan, killed at Ekiti Federal Housing Estate, Ado-Ekiti, on December 19, 2016, a day after the gang killed Taiwo.

Daredevil robbers

The six suspects responsible for the five-day terror in December 2016 were identified as Oseni Raji, 40, Usman Aminu, 27,

Jdris Kamal, 32, and Ahmed Tijani, 23. Others are Anas Muktar, 27, and Abubakar Aliyu, 27.

Their first victim, SUPOL Taiwo, enlisted in the Nigeria Police as Cadet Inspector on June 25, 1994, at Wudeh, Kano State, was a native of Badagry Local Government, Lagos State. He resumed as OC MSS Ekiti State Police Command on December 1, 2014. He was buried on December 20, 2016 at Alapoti Village, Ado-Odo, Ota Local Government, Ogun State.

Enisan, the second victim's android phone was recovered from the suspects. Enisan, who hailed from Ode Irele, Irele Local Government, Ondo State,
