# OAU loses 2 students

**TWO** 300 level students of Obafemi Awolowo University (OAU), Ile Ife have died within one week.

*Daily Sun* learnt that students and departments were in mourning mood after the news of the death of the Barua Yewande, of Public Administration and Jerry

Ashiru, of Sociology and Anthropology departments respectively, hit the campus.

The university management and the students union confirmed their deaths.

Secretary General, Boluwajaiye Adeoluwa and one Oyekan Edward, signed a statement which announced the demise of the two students.

According to the students union, Yewande died during a brief illness on Saturday, April 29, 2017 while Ashiru's cause of death was attributed to an accident on Wednesday, May 3, 2017.

"Our hearts and prayers remain with friends, families, the departments and faculties of the deceased. May the Lord console the

families and grant them the fortitude to bear the loss," the statement stated.

OAU Public Relations Officer, Mr. Abiodun Olarewaju, said the university management has condoled with the families of the deceased's students and that God would give them the fortitude to bear the loss.
