

Again, blood flows in Jol

NO fewer than two people were killed yesterday by suspected Fulani herdsmen in Jol

community of Riyom Local Government Area of Plateau State.

Police Public Relation Officer (PPRO), ASP Tyopev Mar-

thias Terna, confirmed the incident, saying Susan Daniel, a 16 year-old student of Government Secondary School Rim and 29-year-old Joel Choji were

killed while two others were injured.

"We received a report that two persons were killed by gunmen yesterday in Jol community of Riyom local government area of Plateau State. The victims were attacked on the road, shots and macheted while two others survive gun shots injuries."

He noted that investigation has commenced to unravel those behind the killing and said security operatives have been mobilised to watch over the inhabitants to avert any bloody incursion.

Chairman of Riyom Local Government Area, Hon. Emmanuel Danboyi Jugul, said the attack was coming a day after a corpse of Fulani herdsman who was declared missing in the area was recovered in a gutter.

Danboyi lamented that four persons were attacked and two died on the spots while two others were badly injured.

"It is unfortunate that we are recording incidents of attacks, again in Riyom local government, two days ago, the corpse of a Fulani boy that has been missing since last week was found by a search party we organized."

He said the incident of the missing Fulani boy was reported to the special Taskforce on Jos crisis.
