

Hoodlums kill lawyer, another in Rivers

ARMED men have killed a female legal practitioner and another person in Alode community, Eleme Local Government Area of Rivers State.

The victims were killed yesterday evening, when the gunmen invaded the community and attacked the people.

Daily Sun gathered that the female lawyer Mary Obe, means the younger sister to the former prominent youth leader in Eleme, Isaac Obe, who was also assassinated recently, by yet-to-be-identified killers.

Details of the incident were sketchy at the time of filing this report. But, an eyewitness, James Ollor, said the hoodlums stormed the community and shot sporadically.

The State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), (DSP) Nnamdi Omoni, when contacted, said that he was out of the State on official assignment, adding that he needed time to confirm the killing.

Confirming the incident, the Caretaker Committee Chairman of Eleme Local Government Area, Obarimati Ollor, said the gunmen invaded the community and killed two persons.

Ollor said the motive behind the killings were yet to be established and called on the residents to remain calm.
