THE sleepy Eyobisung community in Udung Uko Local Govern-ment Area of Akwa Ibom State is still in shock over the massacre of eight of their natives at night by some unknown persons. Four women, four men, and in one instance, a man and his wife were butchered, on the night of November 22.

Nobody seems to know the actual reason for the massacre but a source in the community alleged that the victims of the killing were accused of being witches and wizards, whose activities led to the sudden death of a councillorship candidate, Duncan Orok-edi, a few days before the incident. Orok-edi was scheduled to stand election on the platform of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) holding on Saturday, December
