Only last Saturday, a young farmer, Moses Gagah, from Akunza Mai giro, Jemkwe development Area, Obi Local Government Area of the state , was allegedly slaughtered in his farm, while several other farmers sustained various degrees of injuries.

Chairman of Miyyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigerian (MACBAN) Nasarawa State chapter, Alhaji Muhammed Hussaini, while addressing herders during a stakeholder's security meeting in Awe Local Government, condemned the violence.

Hussaini, who expressed worries over the activities of Fulani herdsmen, who ceaselessly wreck havoc on the produce of farmers in the area, warned the herders against taking laws into their hands.

He appealed to security agents around to arrest and prosecute any herder found destroying farmers' crops.
