THREE soldiers attached to the military joint task force, Operation Delta Save (ODS) have been feared killed in a fierce gun battle between militants and the military at Toru-Ndoro community in Ekeremor Local Government Area of Bayelsa State.

ex-militant leader terrorising the community, after a security operative was beheaded and his severed head paraded in the community.

Investigations showed that the military had moved in and were combing the community, adjoining communities and the creeks for the hoodlums when the militants launched an attack on them.

Three servicemen, two from the Navy and one from the Army, were reportedly hit with bullets, while seven of the militants were said to have been killed, with several others sustaining bullet wounds and are now in hiding

from the military combing the area.

Findings indicated that the leadership of the ODS, irked by the development, especially the attack on soldiers, has directed that the hoodlums be fished out and brought to book as the military would not condone the killing of soldiers by hoodlums.

A source within the ODS said the cries of molestation and victimisation against the military in the ongoing operation were misplaced as the military would not abdicate its responsibilities and allow a reign of hoodlums that killed soldiers

"Any group of people claiming that

the military is molesting people is not being fair. Any house or people that accommodate people that killed soldiers have lost their right to complain because they are accomplices in the killing of soldiers," he said.

Meanwhile, the Bayelsa State government has explained that the killing of the security operative took place in Edegbene community in Burutu Local Government Area of Delta State.

A statement signed by the Special Adviser to the Governor on Security Matters, Dr. Boma Spero-Jack, said Dickson "condemned the crude, barbaric and reprehensible act of the parading same
