TWO people were killed in a fresh attack on a Borno town on Wednesday by Boko Haram terrorists. The attack came as windstorm

Haram murders 2 in fresh attack

destroyed an IDP camp and injured 19 persons in a border town in the state.

Boko Haram terrorists attacked Kongulon village in Magumeri Local Government Area on Wednesday night, barely five hours after windstorm destroyed 300 units of

tents at the Gamboru/Ngala IDP camp.

Commissioner of Police in the state, Damian Chukwu, confirmed the incident, which he said started at about 3:30pm. He said the storm destroyed other valuables of the IDPs.

"Nineteen IDPs sustained injuries at the camp and are being treated at the camp clinic," he said.

Gamboru/Ngala, a Borno commercial town on the edge of Nigeria-Cameroun border, is about 138 kilometres from Maiduguri, the state

capital. It was captured twice and declared Islamic territory by Boko Haram terrorists between 2014 and 2015. The insurgents were dislodged by Chadian soldiers and regional forces of the Multi-National Joint Task Force in 2015.
