Investigations by Sunday Sun revealed that the recent hostilities broke out following an alleged gun attack on Ijipolo, an Ukele village.

It was learnt that the incident happened last Wednesday when Izzi people allegedly attacked a woman from

Ijipolo in her farm, leaving her in a critical condition.

When news of the attack got to Yala youths, they regrouped for reprisal, claiming that attacks on their communities had been too many of late.

A witness, Mr Justine Egekele, said while the Yala people were preparing for reprisal attack, the Izzi people

launched another attack on Ijipolo and Mfuma villages and inflicted machete cuts on some elders who were returning from a meeting.

Egeleke further said the two villages were invaded and property worth hundreds of thousands of naira destroved.

Sources from the community said some of the victims were receiving treatment at an undisclosed private clinic in Yahe.

The Cross River State Commissioner of Police, Mr Hafiz Inuwa, could not be

reached for comments. But the state Police Public Relations Officer, Ms Irene Ugbo, said the commissioner was on official duty to the conflict
