Dreaded cult leader killed in Rivers

THE leader of a notorious cult group operating within Egbeda and Ubimini communities in Emohua Local Government Area of Rivers State, Mathias Igwe-Ordu, has been killed. Daily Sun gathered that Igwe-Ordu, who

was believed to be the leader of the Iceland cult group, was shot dead by a rival gang in the area during a supremacy clash.

The dreaded cultist, who was an indigene of Ubimini, was killed when he went to assist his gang in Egbeda to fight a rival cult. According to a community source, his death has

made many natives and non-indigenes to flee for fear of reprisals.

The source, identified as Nelson, said the community received news about Igwe-Ordu's killing with mixed feelings.

Chairman of the Egbeda Community Development Committee, Ukwoha Omereji, who confirmed the development, said security has been beefed up in the community. He called on residents of Egbeda community who fled the area to return, assuring them that adequate security has been put in place for protection of life and property.
