## Cult war: 1 killed, scores vounded in Rivers

20-year-old man has been killed and several others sustained machete cuts in a clash between rival cult gangs in the Diobu axis of Port Harcourt, Rivers State

Daily Sun gathered that the cultists also attacked traders and passers-by around Bishop Okoye Street in Mile 3 area of the state capital and dispossessed them of their money and valuables.

A source in the area said that a rival cult gang raided Gambia Street in Diobu, in Port Harcourt to Mile 3 Station disclosed that City Local Government Area, and shot dead a member of a rival cult \_ arrest those behind the attack on group, simply identified as Uche traders and the killing of the sus-Boy. Thereafter, they proceeded to Bishop Okoye, where they carried out another round of attacks.

Another resident, while reacting to the recent attacks by hoodlums, disclosed that communities within Diobu have considered invoking the wrath of the deities against cult groups and criminal

elements in the area.

A senior police officer attached investigation has commenced to pected cult member.

In a related development, the chairman of Rumuodogo Community Development Committee, in Emohua Local Government Area of the state, Ishmael Eze, has narrated the ordeal of his family in the hands of cult members operating in the area

Eze, who spoke from his hosp tal bed in Port Harcourt, said h and his family were attacked b cult members because he wa working with security operative to end criminal activities in the community. He said he started re ceiving threats after he reported to the police that some of ther were involved in the beheading of 12 persons in the community.

He called on the security op eratives to intervene to preven the cult members from sacking
