TWO Nigerian soldiers were killed and nine others wounded in two separate mine blasts in the North-East, where troops are battling Boko Haram extremists, military and militia sources said.

Boko Haram has intensified at-

tacks on military targets in Borno and neighbouring Yobe State in recent months.

The nine-year jihadist conflict, which has spilled into Niger, Cam-eroon and Chad, has claimed 27,000 people and left some 1.8 million homeless in Nigeria alone.
