One dead, 6 injured on Lagos/Ibadan Expressway auto crash

one person has been confirmed dead while six others sustained injuries in an accident involving a Mack truck and a Toyota Hummer bus around Eldorado axis on Lagos/Ibadan Expressway, yesterday.

Public Relations Officer, Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps (TRACE), Babatunde Akinbiyi, confirmed the incident to News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) in

Abeokuta, on Monday.

Akinbiyi stated that the accident, which occurred around 12:40pm was caused by speeding on the part of the bus with registration number KTU 489 XP.

He stated that 16 people, 10 men and six women were involved in the accident, and added that four women and two men were injured, while one woman died.

"The bus, with reg-

istration number KTU 489 XP was on top speed, lost control while trying to overtake and in the process, ran into the moving truck," he said.

The TRACE spokesperson explained that the corpse of the dead was deposited at Fakoya Hospital morgue, Sagamu, while the injured were taken to Supreme Global Hospital, opposite Redeemed Church.
