Similarly, Mrs. Rosemary Osahenrumwen Amadin also through her counsel, approached the panel, asking for N25m as compensation from the panel over the death of her husband, Mr. Amadin Odewingie.

She told the panel that her husband, a truck driver, was chased to his death by SARS unit of the Edo State Police Command at Ologbo in 2019.

Mrs. Amadin said, in order to avoid being shot by the police, he decided to jump into the Ologbo River and when he requested for help, the police allegedly threatened to kill anyone who volunteered to help him.

She said that the police allegedly watched him drowned in the river.

Chairman of the panel, Justice Ada Ehigiamusoe (retd) adjourned in order for the police to also state their own side of the story.
