Lagos family cries to police over murder of son

THE family of Mr. Chijoike Nzugbe, a 25-year-old trader, has cried out over his murder in Lagos.

Nzugbe was allegedly beaten to death in his apartment on 4th Avenue, E Close, Festac Town, Amuwo Odofin Local Government Area of Lagos State, where his body was discovered on Sunday night covered with bruises. The police at Area 'E' Command, Festac Town, have arrested three persons in connection with the murder.

According to a family member, Agwu, the deceased served as an apprentice for seven years in his former mas-

ter's provisions shop at Ebute-Fro Market, Idumota, Lagos Island, after which his master settled him.

He did not pack out of the house, until there were problems between Nzugbe and his master, who gave him a notice to quit, saying he had overstayed his welcome.
