

6 ISWAP terrorists die in clash with Boko Haram

NO fewer than six Islamic State of the West African Province (ISWAP) terrorists were killed in a rival clash with the Boko Haram insurgents affiliated to the Jam'at Ahl as-Sunnah lid-Da'wah wa'l-Jihad, in the fringes of Sambisa forest.
