

“The insecurity in Ekpeye communities has turned to a usual church praise when you talk of killings in Ekpeye, both Ahoada East and Ahoada West. It has become a usual praise. Everyday, people do not sleep with their two eyes closed. Everyday, we record killings. As of last month, April, we had about 36 recorded. In Ekpeye ethnic nationality, we have six clans known as kingdoms.

“The ones we recorded, Ubie has the highest, about 16 (deaths). We have Ahoada, six; we have Akoh three, and machines (motorcycles) stolen. We record daily robberies at Odiemenyi road.
