Soludo vows to prosecute murderers of Anambra community leader From Jeff Amechi Agbodo, Onitsha

ANAMBRA State Governor, Charles Soludo, has condemned the assassination of President General (PG) of Umuoji community in Idemili North Local Government Area of the state, Silas Onyima.

Soludo, however, directed the state security agencies to take immediate and decisive action to apprehend the culprits and ensure swift prosecution of those responsible of criminal acts to deter future recurrences.

The governor's Press Secretary, Christian, in a statement recalled that last Friday gunmen attacked and killed the president general in his place.

According to the governor, "we received with deep concern and immense sadness the news of Onyima's assassination, president general of Umuoji community in Idemili North Local Government Area of the state, which occurred on Friday night.

"On behalf of Anambra State people, the state government unreservedly condemns this heinous act of unprovoked violence.

"We extend our heartfelt condolences to the family of Onyima, the Umuoji community, and the entire Idemili North Local Government Area. This senseless killing represents an affront to the peace and security we are collectively working to build in Anambra State, and Governor Soludo has vowed to ensure that the perpetrators of this dastardly act are brought to justice.
