Gunmen kill 3 in Plateau, youths call for crackdown on militants

NQ fewer than three persons were killed while two others sustained injuries in a midnight attacked by gunmen suspected to be Fulani Militants in Barkin Ladi Local Government Area(LGA) of Plateau State. The National President of Berom Youth

Moulder-Association Dalyop Solomon Mwantiri in a statement yesterday said the attack was carried out on Wednesday November 6, 2024 at about 10:00am when the victims were carrying out their legitimate businesses.

While condemning the incident in its entirety, he called for a crack-down on suspected Fulani militants alleged to be operating in the area to avert any breakdown of law and order with Barkin-Ladi and Riyom LGA respectively.

Mwantiri noted that the recurrence of continued killings, ambushes, assault on women, willful destruction and mass harvested corn and other crops belonging to Berom native inhabitants by Fulani militants and criminal gangs in and around Barkin Ladi, Riyom and part of Jos South LGAs as well as parts of Plateau State should be stemmed with corresponding military action to avoid degeneration of the situation

In his words,"Following the lost of three promising Berom Youths, namely: Chollom Daniel, 27, Jang Joseph, 21, Richard Dapel, 18, who were gruesomely murdered and two others injured while carrying on their legitimate business at about 10:00am of November 6, 2024, is hereby condemned in its entirety.
