Woman dumps baby inside Lagos canal

THE sight of a lifeless day-old baby dumped in a canal along Sebiotimo area of Idi-Mangoro-Agege, Lagos State, stirred anger, curses and tears, yesterday.

The lifeless body of the baby girl was disposed in a manner that passersby would easily notice it.

A resident, Apochi Augustine, said: "It must have been done overnight. This is shameful and must not be encouraged as our youths now engage in reckless promiscuity. How can someone in her right senses do this type of thing in this age when we have many orphanages around? If their parents had done same to them, would they have been alive? "Whoever engages in sex without protection should be ready for the consequences. Her sin would surely find her out?"

A crowd at the scene was seen taking pictures of the baby while hurling curses and abusive words on the perpetrator for dumping the baby in the canal.

An angry man, Etune, described the action as evil even as he heaped curses on the perpetrator.

"This is not the first time they are doing this around here. It's almost every time and no one is doing anything about it."
