

Calm In Nigeria After Clashes Kill Hundreds

The Red Cross in Nigeria has told Sky News calm has been restored in the city of Jos after 460 people were killed in religious clashes.



Police and military troops have restored calm after several days of religious clashes

The presence of troops and police in the city and the relaxing of a 24-hour curfew prevented further outbreaks of the violence that has also injured 1,000.

The **Red Cross** estimates 17,000 people have been displaced and are taking shelter in colleges, hospitals and schools since the fighting began on Sunday.

The calm will allow religious leaders to travel to nearby communities and bury the dead.

They said there was an urgent need for food, water and clothing.

Robin Waudo, of the Red Cross in Jos, told Sky News: "There are many injured being treated in hospital, we estimate 900 people.

"There are varying accounts of what started the fighting. We're more concerned with the injured.

"We've seen gunshot wounds, machete wounds and a lot of broken limbs and fractures.

"The wounded include 220 who have been arrested by the police and we've been giving them first aid." Jos has been the centre of several major religious clashes in Nigeria.

Mosque officials have estimated the number of dead Muslims since Sunday at about 400.

US-based Human Rights Watch on Wednesday said at least 65 Christians had died.

Official government figures were significantly lower at 75 dead, more than 200 injured and 200 arrested.

More than 200 ethnic groups live side-by-side in Nigeria.

A million people were killed in a civil war between 1967 and 1970 and there have been outbreaks of religious unrest since then.
