They were allegedly cruising and surveying unsuspected commuters in their black coloured Volkswagen car with registration number, Delta

AG 625 DSZ, with four occupants before the on-slaught.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Celestina Kalu, at the headquarters in Asaba yesterday, said the hoodlums opened fire to beat arrest.

She said: "The team flagged the occupants to stop for a search, but they opened fire on the patrol men. In the ensuing gun duel, one of the suspected armed robbers was gunned down while the others disembarked from

the vehicle and escaped with bullet wounds."

Kalu listed the items abandoned by the gang to include one K2 rifle No. 97000 with a magazine and 12 rounds of live ammunition; one G3 rifle No. 8112982, its magazine, 16 rounds of live ammunition and their operational Volkswagen Jetta car with registration No. Delta AG 625 DSZ.

While she said the command had swung into intensive investigations to track down the fleeing bandits, she narrated how a suspected kidnapper was nabbed in Ndokwa East axis of the state.

"Following information that suspected kidnappers were sighted around Okpara Inland, detectives attached to Isiokolo Division mobilised to the scene and arrested one Saturday Oyouvwe 'm,' Samson Iroorowo 'm' and Janet Onya Akpowene 'f.' Items recovered from the suspects include one locally made short gun."
