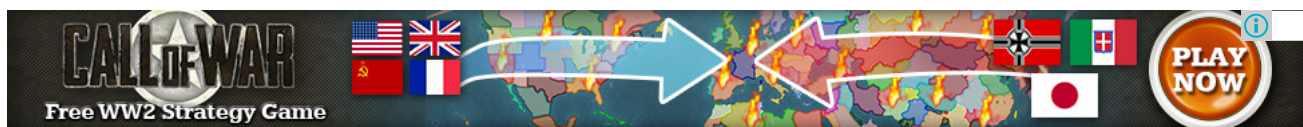
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Hundreds of angry youths from Ase- Omukeye and Otulu-Ogwashi- Uku communities in Ndokwa East and Aniocha South Local Government Areas of Delta State yesterday besieged the Government House, Asaba, protesting the alleged killing of their youths.

Reports from the area said four youths were gruesomely murdered in cold blood when a team of policemen from Abuja came to Ase-Omuke to arrest some hoodlums. Expressing their anger in Asaba, elders and leaders of the communities wondered why the perpetrators were not brought to book. The elders and leaders, who spoke separately during the protest, urged Governor Ifeanyi Okowa to urgently address the matter in the interest of justice and peace.

Chairman and the Secretary of the Ase-Omuke Community Development Committee, Chief Okwudili Obi and Mr. Victor Ogbue respectively, expressed shock that the alleged murderers have since been released unconditionally. They accused the Attorney- General and Commissioner for Justice, Mr. Peter Mrakpor, of perverting justice, querying his 'no case to answer by the suspects' comment.'
