vehicle was also reported to have been attacked by another group along the same road during which they kidnapped two of the passengers.

When contacted for comments, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of the state Police Command, DSP Shehu Muhammad, confirmed the incidence, saying only two people were reported to have been kidnapped, and that they were already rescued by the police who currently cordoned off the area apparently to arrest the perpetrators.
